

Los Gigantes, Tenerife



Valencia


is the capital of the autonomous community of Valencia and the third-largest city in Spain after Madrid and Barcelona

Salmorejo

Churros

it is a greasy Spanish baking made from deep-pressed dough and fried at high temperature
